

Vermont Insurance ABA Codes 3.14.18

- Assume all codes/behaviors have to be done with client present and with supervision of the BCBA unless wise noted.
- Initial Assessment for all insurance companies must be done and billed by a BCBA.
- It is up to the lead BA on a case to understand the allotment and bx of codes to make sure we are providing the services as requested and allotted.
- ABA policies for all insurance companies can be accessed through intake coordinator as well.
- The term “others” in descriptions includes S^D staff, family members or other home-based caregivers (PCAs, etc) – not school staff
